

DIVISION EMBLEM: On a shield per bend azure (light and dark blue for day and night), a griffin segreant or.

SIGNIFICANCE: The emblem portrays in visible form the mission of the 35th Air Division (Defense), and represents a state of vigilance and readiness under all weather conditions, day or night. The mission of the 35th Air Division (Defense) is to conduct the air defense of the United States within a sector of responsibility designated by the Commander, Central Air Defense Force. The shield is diagonally divided from upper left to lower right. The lower left sector is colored dark blue, signifying night; this sector also signifies bad weather. The upper right sector is light blue, signifying day as well as good weather. The griffin segreant, in gold, signifies vigilance and readiness to strike. The total significance of the emblem denotes a state of vigilance and readiness to strike, day or night, under all weather conditions.

HISTORY: The Hq, 35th Air Division (Defense) was constituted 11 Jun 51 and activated 1 Jul 51 at Kansas City, Missouri.
